The weeks seem to certainly passing by very quickly. Thank you to Mr Charlton who wrote the Blog for last week. We intend for this to become a more regular feature as we both work together alongside the staff team to move forwards on school development, improvements and activities for all the children.

The staff are beginning to work with the children on their Christmas plays and performances. Information regarding how you can get tickets will be sent out by early December. It was lovely to be part of the PTA Christmas treat to Early Years as they went to see The Hungry Caterpillar at Alnwick Playhouse. The children's behaviour was a credit to their families and Mrs Marsden's team. Thank you, as always to the parents who helped out on this and recent trips. Your help is greatly appreciated.

As a staff, we continue to look at the recent parent questionnaires that were returned and we are really pleased with how well received our PE and Forest Schools provision is. Classroom size was mentioned as a negative alongside teaching assistant ratios. We are pleased to clarify that we currently have a 1:9 pupil to staff ratio which is below national averages and considerably below our pre-COVID staffing ratios which we hope to continue well into the future as this is working well and we are seeing good rates of progress and achievement across the school for our pupils.
