Code of Conduct for use of School Field after school, at weekends and during School Holidays

Updates in place – April - September 2024

Only children / families who have signed a copy and returned this to school are permitted to use school grounds

Copies need to be signed annually and returned to school

Community use of the School Field after school 3.30-7.30 (or dusk if sooner) in Spring and Summer unless an after school club is running then only when the club has finished, at weekends and school holidays is permitted on the basis of reasonable and responsible use.

Please note the safety of the school grounds play equipment is checked on an annual basis and in term time during the school week but no such checks are made after school, at weekends or during school holidays and therefore users are using the grounds at their own risk. Please do not enter the school site before dawn or after dusk as there is no external lighting and is therefore unsafe to do so.

Risk Assessments of the equipment and area are to be completed and we would encourage users to wait until these have been completed and are shared. If you intend to use the grounds prior to this, then please remember that use of the school grounds is at your own risk.
