Literacy

The children will progress through our Literacy programme – Read Write Inc (RWI), that teaches reading, writing and spelling. They will continue to learn new letter sounds which will help them to become fluent readers. They will explore different genres of writing including narrative and non-fiction

Maths

Year 1 children will learn to: find ½ and ¼ of shapes, name and describe 2D shapes and 3D shapes, find 10 more/less than a 2-digit number, find doubles to double 20, order days of the week and months of the year, count in 10s from 10; find 10 more/less than a 2-digit number.

Year 2 children will learn to: find odd and even numbers, find ¼ and ¾ of shapes, identify and describe common 2D and 3D shapes (faces, vertices and edges), use Venn and Carroll diagrams to sort objects and shapes, compare numbers using < and >; round 2-digit numbers to nearest the multiple of 10, find doubles to double 20 and related halve.

Times tables (Y2)

Year 2 children will continue to have a weekly times table test as started last year. This test will be on a **Monday.** Year 1 children will start to learn times tables

Reading



We will continue with our Guided Reading sessions whereby the children take it in turns to read aloud within the group. This provides a good opportunity for discussion around the text and a deeper understanding of what has been read.

As the children continue to move through the reading stages the text will become more challenging and the amount of text on each page will increase. As such do not feel that you should complete one text in the space of one evening if you do not feel this is appropriate for your child. It is important that your child understands what they are reading so please do spend time asking them questions. You can further help support your child's reading by focusing on reading with fluency (reading HFW automatically) and reading with expression.

Please note that whilst I try to read with the children on a set day each week this does not always happen. As I am sure you can appreciate there can be changes to our timetable due to various reasons.

Number bonds of 10 (Y1) and number bonds of 20 and 100 (Y2)

A number bond is a pair of numbers that add up to another number. Y1 children have already learned their number bonds of 5 and 10. For example, 1+9=10, 2+8=10, 3+7=10. These number bonds are the foundation blocks your child needs to progress with maths. Please help your child to practise these important number facts at home. Please watch out for a number bond sheet in your child's homework book. Thank you.

Geography

We will use world maps, atlases and globes to help compare different animal groups and where they live. This will involve locating the world's seven continents and five oceans.

Computing

We will use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content. This will involve researching different animals.

*Please continue to help your child log into their School 360 account using their username and password details (see homework book). It is very helpful if the children can log on independently when working in


Music

Art and DT


