Dear Parents/Caregivers

As part of our learning this term, the children will be taking part in an exciting tractor-themed project linked to the Glendale Agricultural Countryside Day. During these sessions, the children will explore the features, parts, and purpose of tractors while developing their designing and making skills.

The children will be learning about:

- Different types of tractors and what they are used for
- Important tractor features such as wheels, exhaust pipes, ladders, hitches, and the driver's cab
- How tractors help farmers and support farming in the countryside
- Designing and creating their own tractor ideas using recyclable materials

To support the design stages of this project, we would be very grateful if your child could bring in a few small, clean recyclable items that may be useful for model making.

Suggested items include:

- Small boxes or cartons
- Bottle tops or yoghurt lids for wheels, variety sizes
- Cardboard tubes or straws
- Clean plastic containers
- Foil trays, foil cartons, or other interesting recyclable material
- Additional features such as lights, wing mirrors, ladders, or any other creative ideas your child may have to complete their tractor. Please feel free to be as creative as you like!

Please ensure all items are clean and safe for use in school. If all items could be brought into school on or before Wednesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June in time for our session that afternoon it would be much appreciated.

We are looking forward to seeing the children's creativity and helping them develop their understanding of farming machinery through this exciting project.
