In English, we have been really putting our knowledge into practice with our most recent genres in particular. Continuing with this, we will be looking at creating a formal letter of complaint through firstly studying an example, understanding its features and then using this to create our own. This will use emotive and persuasive language within a formal voice to gain the necessary effect on the reader.
Statistics - Interpreting line graphs - Drawing line graphs to represent data - Interpreting pie charts - Drawing pie charts - Drawing pie charts - Fractions and pie charts - Percentages and pie charts - Statistical terms – mean, range, mode and median. The end of this half term will involve strengthening and developing further key aspects of maths from the academic year.	Our next genre that we will study, explore and then create is a descriptive recount. This will focus on using high-calibre vocabulary as well figurative language. The children are sure to enjoy this one in particular as they will be basing this on sherbet lemons sweets (Albus Dumbledore's favourite). Report writing will be our next genre to explore and create. This will be based on a fictional accident report where we will be looking at using formal voice whilst using detailed descriptions, technical vocabulary and complex sentences. We will also be writing descriptive recounts of our best memories from school in preparation for the Leavers' service at the end of the term.

Our PE this half-term will all be on Tuesday afternoon with our use of Willowburn Leisure Centre for swimming or dance. Key vocabulary: Float, buoyancy, strokes, streamline, stamina, stretching, resistance, balance, teamwork, solo, positions, movement, emotion, expression.	For Music for this whole term, we will be looking at songs in preparation for our Big Sing and Leavers' service performances. This will cover a range of songs in several styles that will be explored and studied along the way.Key vocabulary: Musical, unison, harmony, chorus, choir, pitch, timbre, duration, rhythm, pulse, tempo, time signature, stave, clef, notation, dynamics.
In Geography, we will be studying both the physical geography and human geography of Northumberland over time. This will include the study of local landmarks such as the Cheviots as well as Alnwick town and castle. We will look at the features, climate, topography and location of Alnwick and how this has influenced the use of the land both regionally but also nationally. <u>Kev vocabulary:</u> Physical geography, human geography, topography, climate, push and pull factors, migration, trade, agriculture, finance, democracy, population.	 Our topic this term is Earth and Space. We will learn to: Describe the movement of the Earth, and other planets, relative to the Sun in the solar system. Describe the movement of the Moon relative to the Earth Describe the Sun, Earth and Moon as approximately spherical bodies Use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky. We will also be going on our Science class trip to the Life Centre in Newcastle.

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In RE - We use the Northumberland County Council Agreed Syllabus for Religious Education and will be learning about the Religion and teachings of Buddhism this term.

In our RSHE /PHSE work we will be learning that we all have differences but that these must be respected; understanding physical and emotional boundaries in friendships; exploring the roles of a bully, victim and bystander; looking at how our

behaviour affects others and expected manners in different situations.
