Trip to Brinkburn Priory - Lifepath - Friday 27th June 2025 (9.15am until 3pm)

Dear Parents / Caregivers,

Class 2 have been invited to take part in an annual event at Brinkburn Priory which is organised by the Mustard Tree Trust, The United Reform Church and the Scripture Union. There will be some familiar faces there from the 'Open the Book' collective worship volunteers who come to school.
