In Literacy there will also be a focus on phonics work for the Year 1 children as well as spelling, grammar, punctuation and handwriting for all



children. It is expected that children will read to an adult at home every night for a minimum of 10 - 15 minutes and that their reading record is signed.

The children, especially those in Year 2 can also comment in their reading record to say what they enjoyed about the book. The children will also be writing information texts based on sharks and polar animals. They will also write stories based on The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch as well as poems and posters. Reading books should be in school every day.

In Numeracy the children will be focusing on place value and addition and subtraction. They will also be developing their skills in mathematical fluency, reasoning and problem solving. As well as learning about shape and money.



In Geography the children will learn about the four countries, and their capital cities, which make up the United Kingdom and its surrounding seas.

They will also record the weather which will be an ongoing project across the year noticing changes in the weather and the seasons.

As part of this work the children will also learn about the points of a compass.



In R.E the children will be learning about Christianity: God and Jesus. This will include ways in which Jesus is special to Christians and some of Jesus' friends.

They will also learn about the Christian Celebrations and festivals during the months of September through to December.





In Computing the children will learn about staying safe online, keeping personal information private and identifying where to go for help and support. They will also learn how to log on and save and retrieve information. Online technologies will also be used across the curriculum.
