After School Clubs

We are expecting our After School Clubs on Monday and Tuesday to continue as we expect the current children to continue to use this service so can run this service without losing money. If you would like your child to attend and they do not already attend please contact the office. Please note, to help us dismiss the children safely pick up times are: 4.15, 5.15 and 5.30. All clubs will run to the end of term (including the last week unless you are notified otherwise). Clubs are charged per half term whether your child attends or not and refunds will only be made if school have had to cancel.

Mondays - 3.15- 4.15 Sports Club then 4.15-5.30 'Chill Club' with Mrs Manners. All ages welcome. Tuesdays - 3.15 - 4.15 Arts and Crafts (using natural materials where possible) then 4.15-5.30 'Chill Club'.All ages welcome. Cost per session is £3.50 for the first hour and £7.50 until 5.30 In addition to this, we have the opportunity for two more clubs which are open to older children only and are limited in size (they will also not run if there is not sufficient interest).

Wednesdays - Gardening Club. We will also open this to Year 2 as well as Y3-6 for the final half term of the year. 3.15-5.15 with Mrs Chisholm. Numbers are limited and cost is subsidised due to funding left over from last year by Alnwick Rotary Club.
