## <u> Grammar - Week 5</u>

**Common noun** = <u>person</u>, <u>place</u> or <u>thing</u> that doesn't need a capital letter *e.g. woman*, *sweet*, *tablet*, *city*.

**Proper noun** = <u>person</u>, <u>place</u> or <u>name</u> of something that starts with a capital letter *e.g.* Bob, Dr Doolittle, IPad, Liverpool.

Adjective = describing word

**Verb** = doing word (often ends in 'ing')
