Mr Charlton will be leading this and will be in touch by letter once final details have been confirmed.

New Childcare Reforms

You may already be aware, starting from April 2024, existing childcare support will be expanded for working families. This means that: From **April 2024**, working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours childcare support. Parents can apply for their funded childcare codes through the Childcare Choices website from 2nd January 2024.

We are pleased to offer some afternoon places for **Rising 3 Year Olds** 11.45-3.15 for working parents or a fee paying place through our Community Powers Nursery from 15th April 2024 using our school environment and specialist facilities for younger children.


NON-UNIFORM DAY
