


#### Events for the New Year -

#### Before and After School Clubs for Spring Term 1

Dear Parents/Carers,

First of all, thank you to everyone whose children have attended our range of before and after school clubs this half term and the positive feedback these have received. Secondly, thanks to staff for putting in many additional hours, away from their own families to enable this.

We will continue to run our early bird club for the whole of Spring Term in the hope that we will have further support to enable this club to be financially viable.

This club is 8.00-8.45 and the cost is only £2.00 per child per session. Drop in available at £5.00 per session (please check the club is running beforehand). Mondays to Thursdays.

#### **Late Club (Nursery - Year 6)**

**Tuesdays** will continue for the whole of Spring Term at least.

However, we may be able to staff an additional night (Thursdays) subject to minimum numbers. Please let the office know if you would be interested in this. Costs will remain at £3.50 per child for clubs that last an hour and to £7.00 for clubs that run until 5.30 unless you are informed differently.
