Do you... Play the Right Way?

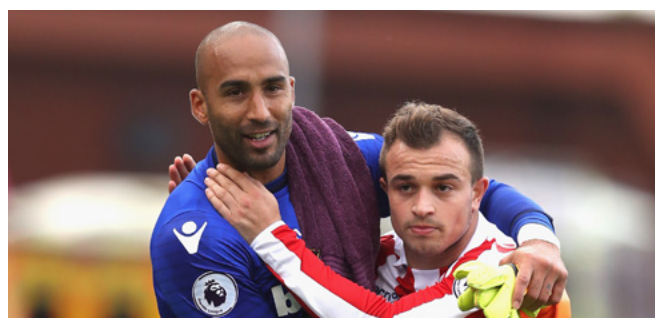
Objective: To support pupils in identifying the most positive ways to approach football matches, working together and setting a great example to others.
