Swimming and Specialist Sports Facilities at Willowburn School Year 2017-18.

Class 1 (Year 1 and 2) and Class 2 (Year 3 and 4) will continue to swim and use the specialist facilities at Willowburn from September. Class 3 are going to develop their sporting provision with a new range of activities such as bike ability, mountain biking, geo caching, archery, outdoor and adventurous activities and will be the first of our children to work on the ArchBishop of York Young Leaders award from the second half of the Autumn Term.
