Dear Parents/Legal Guardians,

So far this term, children have been set daily reading, Sumdog online tasks and phonics to practise. Each child has now been given some homework books to enhance this provision. Please could you work with your children to complete the tasks:

Year 1 children

Maths Daily Practice Book- one page a day

Phonics Buster- one page a week

KS1 year 1 Targeted Question Book- one page a week

Year 2 children

KS1 Maths Reasoning- one page a week

KS1 Maths Arithmetic- one page a week

KS1 English Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling- one page a week

KS1 English Reading- one comprehension every 2 weeks

Please note that due to the current circumstances regarding COVID 19, these books cannot be returned to school each week to be marked by your child's class teacher. Until procedures change please mark these with your child and encourage them to correct any questions they may have answered incorrectly. Any comments, feedback and uploaded photos can be sent to your class teacher through Class Dojo to enable them to ensure that homework is being completed and that it is set at the correct standard..

In the event of your child needing to take time of school to self-isolate, or for any future school closure due to COVID-19, please could children complete one page from each booklet every week day. The tasks in the books match with curriculum coverage for each half term and are good revision for the children, should they need to be off school. As well as these activities, please can the children continue to read with an adult each day. This can be recorded and sent to your child's class teacher on Class Dojo, as they do not have home-school reading logs this year.

We are also monitoring in school how long the children spend on Sumdog activities each week, as well as checking to see that they are completing a range of activities for Maths and English on this resource.

Please note that the expectation in KS1 is to know all your number bonds to 10, 20 and 100 and many children would benefit from practising this. There are online activities that the children use in school and can also access at home, such as J2E Blast on School 360, which can help with this.
