### After School Club

As you will know from the school website calendar, the last ASC for this school year was Thursday 15th December. Following feedback from this term I have taken this opportunity to review our provision and we are going to offer Mondays as STEM club

3.15-4.15 where the children will take part in fun scientific and technological experiments and then from 4.15 it will be a chance for the children to eat their snack and relax with less focussed activities.

If Tuesdays go ahead this will be Arts and Crafts 3.15-4.15 where the children will get the chance to really develop their creative skills and produce an item at the end of the clubs.

Payment will need to be based on the whole half term whether your child attends or not as we cannot afford to run it in any other way.

If you do need a drop in, one off session on the day(s) we run club(s) this will be available depending on space and will be £10 per child 3.15-5.30 or £5 per child
