


# Draw 2D shapes


1 Draw two different squares.


2 Draw three different rectangles.


3 Draw three different triangles.


5 Compare all the shapes you have drawn with a partner. What differences can you see?

6 Annie is drawing a 2D shape.




Draw Annie's shape.

He has spilt ink on his drawing.





What could Teddy's shape be? e.g. square


