## New Childcare Reforms

Dear Parents / Caregivers,
You may already be aware, starting from April 2024, existing childcare support will be expanded for working families. This will be done in phases. By September 2025, most working families with children under the age of 5 will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare support from the term after their child turns 9 months old.

The changes are being introduced gradually to make sure that providers can meet the needs of more families. This means that:

From April 2024, working parents of 2-year-olds will be able to access 15 hours childcare support. Parents can apply for their funded childcare codes through the Childcare Choices website from 2 ${ }^{\text {nd }}$ January 2024.

From September 2024, 15 hours childcare support will be extended to working parents of children from the age of 9 months to 3 -year-olds.

From September 2025, working parents of children under the age of 5 will be entitled to 30 hours of childcare a week.

Like the existing offer, depending on your chosen provider, these hours can be used over 38 weeks of the year (during school term time), or up to 52 weeks if you use fewer than your total hours per week. For more information, please click on the following link Childcare Choices
