RE: Y6 transition days to DCHS

Dear parents/ caregivers,

As part of their transition programme, the Duchess Community High School (DCHS) will be having two transition days where the Year 6 pupils that will be going to DCHS in the next academic year are able to attend DCHS and a pre-planned and arranged day of activities has been organised and will be run by DCHS staff. These 'taster days' are scheduled to be on the **3rd and 10th of July** (both are Wednesdays).

If your child is going to be attending DCHS in the next academic year, then on the 3rd and 10th July, you will need to make arrangements for them to be dropped off a DCHS at 9:15am where Mrs Athey will be in front of the school's reception area at the entrance to meet and greet them. Parents/caregivers will then need to collect their child(ren) again from the front of DCHS at 2:30pm. (If parents/caregivers want to organise shared drop-off/pick-up arrangements, that is absolutely fine but is to be arranged by yourselves.)

- Morning = sports activity (P.E. kits and sunscreen needed) and carousel of extracurricular activities
- LUNCH packed lunch needed
- Afternoon = Review of the day Q&A activity
