Last term brought us our lowest overall attendance in 20 years. This was a topic For discussion at our Autumn Term Governors Meeting this week. Every term we receive a visit from the Education Welfare Officer. Any child who has less than 95% attendance will now automatically receive a letter informing parents of this and if we have episodes of continued attendance below 95% (unless there are specific medical needs) the Education Welfare Officer will be informed. Please refer to all the guidance information that will go home with your child today that stresses the importance of high attendance and punctuality on future educational outcomes. The Governing Body have made this an agenda item for each Full Governing Body Meeting and we hope to see attendance improving.

The vast majority of KS1 and 2 parents did not want the Family Learning Projects to continue. 23 out of 26 parents wanted homework to concentrate on basic skills and reading. Almost all parents wanted workshops in how we teach Mathematics and English skills so we will be arranging those soon. Online learning proved popular with a Homework Club also being requested. With this in mind I will be offering a KS2 online learning homework club after half term. Please refer to the After School Club letter for further details.
