SPANA's mission is to improve the welfare of working animals in the world's poorest communities. We do this through treatment, training and teaching. Countless families across the world depend on horses, mules, donkeys, camels and oxen for their livelihoods – and sometimes even their lives. These hardworking animals are the backbone of many societies, yet their lives can be short and involve great suffering. Working day after day in extreme temperatures, often with poor harnessing, little food and no veterinary care when they are sick or injured many working animals endure constant pain.
