


Class 2 Topic Letter Summer Term 1 2017

In Literacy the children will be looking at poetry and myths and legends.



We will continue using reciprocal reading strategies to develop our reading comprehension skills through our guided reading, as well as increasing understanding of written grammar through writing analysis.

In Numeracy the children will be continuing to develop their understanding of problem solving through investigation. We will also focus on geometry - looking at the properties of shapes, as well as position and direction and telling the time.

In Topic the children will be learning all about the Ancient Egyptians. We will be looking at the geography of Egypt and the importance of the River Nile, as well as learning about the Egyptians and their culture and traditions. This will then lead into

In Science We will be looking at how light travels in straight lines and that objects are seen because they give out or reflect light into the eye.



In French the children will continue their language learning through the happy language scheme 'La Jolie Ronde'. We will begin to use our language skills to describe ourselves and the world around us.

In R.E the children will be learning about the similarities and differences in world religions and how they worship, with a particular focus on Islam.
