SO WHAT'S INVOLVED?



Creating exciting theatrical performances using a blend of singing, acting and movement to tell a story.

Creating a performance for an audience: making a programme, managing costume changes, manipulating props, introducing songs, creating connections between item in a programme.



Working on performing songs from a range of musicals from different eras and individual songs in a musical theatre style (such as cabaret or songs from films and TV). Developing a deeper understanding of the music and how the interpretation of it can enhance the story telling.

Can I aim for Qualifications in Musical Theatre?

Students can work towards nationally recognised exams in Musical Theatre from the London College of Music. Exams from Grade 6 onwards carry UCAS points.

A Musical Theatre exam involves: Performance including costumes and use of props Discussion Written Programme and Introductions
